

1. Respiratory sequelae in children post laryngotracheal stenosis repair are caused by the remaining stenosis, as well as A- frame deformations at the site of previous tracheal cannula and pre-existing co-morbidities. (*this thesis*)
2. Dynamic evaluation by upper airway MRI adds clinically relevant information for the follow up of paediatric laryngotracheal stenosis. (*this thesis*)
3. Also preterm born children not meeting the National Health Institute diagnostic criteria of bronchopulmonary dysplasia can have clinically significant structural lung changes. (*thesis*)
