### ***'Optimizing performance and techniques in advanced pancreatobiliary endoscopy'***

1. Simulator training should be considered as an integral part in the training curricula for ERCP.

2. Mandatory registration provides valuable insight in ERCP performance rates in the Netherlands and makes ERCP performers more conscious and critical about their own performance. *This thesis*
3. Pancreatoscopy with EHL holds promise as first-line treatment for patients with chronic pancreatitis and obstructing stones in the head or the neck of the pancreas if ductal access is secured. *This thesis*
4. Preliminary experience shows that the EndoRotor is a safe and effective endoscopic tool in the treatment of patients with infected necrotizing pancreatitis. *This thesis*
5. Endoscopic ampullectomy is a safe and effective treatment in patients with lateral spreading adenomas. *This thesis*
6.
